Tasting Note

2007 'Old Broke Block' Semillon



Vineyard : The Old Broke Block at Glenguin. Vine age now 15 years and a mixture of clones and rootstock including Busby, BVCR13 on Schwartzmann, Ramsey and own roots. Sandy loam soils with permanent sod culture utilizing organic vineyard practices to the maximum possible.

Winemaking ; Grapes picked mid harvest at 10 to 11 be, fermented dry in steel with no malic or oak influence. Left on lees for 5 months prior to bottling.

The Wine : Classic unwooded low alcohol Hunter semillon but with a measure of ripe citrus fruit characters and low SO2 making for an attractive young wine. The 2007 has the crisp racy mouth-watering acidity typical of this vineyard.

Alcohol: 10.5%

Closure: Screwcap.
